### **Overview of Ministry**

In 1929, Hillview Acres Children's home began in Ontario, CA to provide services to abandoned children. In 1965 Hillview moved to its current 12.7 acres in Chino, California. Prior to the 1970's, children came to Hillview from indigent families, having been primarily abandoned or neglected. From the 1970's on Hillview saw a significant change in the nature of the children coming to the agency. These children were more the victims of physical and sexual abuse. The degree of trauma these children experienced was significantly more severe than in the previous decades. With those changes came the need for Hillview to adjust its services to meet these greater issues. Today, Hillview Acres Children's Home is a 24-hour treatment center licensed by the State of California for some of the most abused children in social services. These services include everything from 24 hour care by trained child care staff, case management, therapy, psychiatric help, educational assistance, full assessment services and even Teen Pregnancy/Teen Parenting.

Although these services are necessary for all these children, Hillview is at its core a Christian-based agency. We serve the needs of abused children to honor the Lord. With that in mind, Hillview established a chaplaincy program for the purpose of providing a focal point for spiritual questing and concerns for both staff and children. This program has been highly successful in helping both deal with some deep spiritual issues.
